Contract & Agreement.

This contract and agreement made and entered into this 22nd day of November A.D. 1907 in duplicate by and between Webster C. Baker of Collinsville, Rogers County Oklahoma, party of the first part and the Olive Oil Company of Tulsa, Oklahoma, a corporation doing business under the laws of the state of Oklahoma, party of the second part.

Witnesseth: That the party of the second part did on the 6th day of November 1907 purchase an oil and gas mining lease on the allotment of the said Webster C. Baker that is situated in Tulsa County Oklahoma more particularly described as follows to-wit:

The east one half of the Southwest quarter of section nine, Twp. 21 North, Range 13 East of the Indian Base and Meridian, that was sold in the office of and by the Hon. C. W. Butterworth, the then duly qualified and acting probate commissioner at Tulsa, Ind. Terr. according to a general order issued by the United States Court for the Western District of the Indian Territory on the 5th day of June 1907, providing for the sale of minor leased for oil and gas mining purposes for Two Hundred and Seventy-five dollars for a period of one year and twenty-four days and no longer than the expiration of the minority of the party of the first part, and

Whereas the party of the first part is desirous of having the above described land immediately developed for oil and gas mining purposes, and

Whereas the party of the second part is also desirous of developing the said land for said oil and gas mining purposes, and

Whereas to develop the same requires an
