Therefore it is hereby agreed by and between the parties to this contract that upon the compliance and fulfillment of the above stipulations and requirements of the party of the first part herinbefore set forth this contract and the said note jointly executed by the party of the first part, with John H. Baker, Elizabeth Baker, Sarah E. Jackson and Ella S. Butler and in favor of the party of the second part for the sum of Eight thousand \$50.00 Dollars dated November 22nd, 1907, and eighteen months after date and a certain real estate mortgage executed by Elizabeth Baker and John H. Baker her husband to the party of the second part to secure the payment of the above described note shall be void and of no effect, otherwise to remain in full force, effect and virtue. In witness whereof the party of the first part for himself, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns has hereunto set his hand and the party of the second part has by its proper and duly authorized officers, the President and Secretary of the said Olive Oil Company have hereunto in behalf of the said party of the second part set their respective names and affixed their corporate seal on this the 22nd day of November A. D. 1907.
