Contract & Agreement.

The contract and agreement made and entered into and delivered this the 22nd day of November A. D. 1907, by and between John H. Baker, Elizabeth Baker, Sarah E. Jackson and Ella J. Butte, all of Rogers County, State of Oklahoma, parties of the first part and The Olive Oil Company, a Corporation of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, doing business by virtue of the State of Oklahoma, parties of the second part.

Witnesseth: - That the parties of the second part did on the sixth day of November A. D. 1907 purchase an Oil and Gas Mining Lease on the allotment of Webster C. Baker, a minor, and son of John H. Baker and Elizabeth Baker, said land or allotment is situated in the Northern part of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, and more fully described as follows, to wit:

The east one half (1/2), of the southwest quarter (1/4) of section nine (9) township twenty-one (21) North, Range thirteen (13) East, that was sold by the Honorable C. W. Butterworth at that time the duly appointed, qualified and acting Probate Commissioner for the Western District of the Indian Territory at Tulsa, Indian Territory, said lease was sold by virtue of a general order issued by the United States Court for the aforesaid District, on the fifth day of June A. D. 1907 for selling oil and gas mining leases of minors, and

Whereas said lease only runs for a period of one year and twenty-four days, or until the said Webster C. Baker arrives at his majority, twenty-one years old, that the said Webster C. Baker is desirous of having the said lease immediately developed for
