

Assignment of Rental Contract.

Know all Men, By these presents that we, E. J. Randall and James Randall of Gray, S. D. for and in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred Dollars and seven dollars (\$307.00) due in Land said receipt of which is hereby acknowledged do hereby sell assign and transfer unto H. H. Snider, of Broken Arrow, D. C. all our right title and interest in and to the following described tract of land to wit: Lots one (1) and two (2) and the South half of the North East Quarter of Section one (1) Township Eighteen (18) North, Range Thirteen (13) East, Creek Nation Indian Territory, which interest we have and hold under a certain rental contract dated the 22nd day of January 1904, executed by Flora Seaman Parker and her husband G. W. Parker in favor of us the said E. J. & James Randall and we hereby covenant with said H. H. Snider that we will deliver up to him or his agent on or before the first day of January 1906, the possession of said premises all the improvements required to be put on the same by us, except the barn and stable mentioned in said contract and we further covenant with the said H. H. Snider that we will on or before the 25th day of November 1905, erect said barn or stable on said premises according to the terms of said contract and further covenant with said Snider that all rent moneys due said allottee Flora Seaman Parker under said contract are paid in full up to January 1st 1906.
