Witnesseth: That for and in consideration of the money rental herein after set out and the mutual covenants and agreements in this contract contained, the party of the first part, has this day and by these presents hereby relinquishes, releases and sets over unto the party of the second part, his heirs, administrators and assigns for the term beginning August 12th 1910 and ending December 30th 1912 the following described piece or parcel of land to wit: The North-west quarter of the South west quarter of Section 16, Township 17, North and Range 14 East at a money rental of \$50.00 for the term of this lease in cash the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged in full payment for the full term of this lease.

Do have and to hold the foregoing premises for either grazing or agricultural purposes for the term above mentioned. Noah Grant.
