

Sharp Rogers { Rental Contract.
 To
 W. M. Welch. This contract and agreement made
 & entered into this the 25th day of
 November 1907 by and between Sharp Rogers, as Guar-
 dian of his minor son Gratt D. Rogers, age 16
 years, party of the first part, and W. M. Welch party
 of the second part:-

Witnesseth: - That for and in consideration
 of the sum of Four Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$450)
 Three Hundred Dollars of which has been paid to
 hand the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged
 and the sum of One hundred and Fifty dollars to be
 paid by the said party of the second part one hundred
 of said sum on Dec. 12th 1907 and the balance of
 said sum Fifty Dollars, on Sept. 15th 1908, the said party
 of the first part hereby rents, lets, and leases to the said
 party of the second part for agricultural purposes
 for the term of Five (5) years to be computed from
 the first day of November 1907, expiring on the first day
 of November 1912, to wit S. 1/2 of S. 16, 1/4 of Sec. 10 Township
 20 N. Range 13 East containing 80 acres being the
 allotment of Gratt D. Rogers, a minor.

It is understood and agreed by and between
 the parties hereto that the said party of the second part
 shall have the right to sub-rent or lease the said
 land, for any part of the unexpired term of this lease.

It is understood and agreed that the said party
 of the second part shall have the right to cut, clear and
 break up any part of said tract of land, and to sell and
 dispose of any timber growing on said tract, except
 walnut and our oak timber. Witness our hands this
 the day and year first above written.
