This Agreement made and entered into this the 5 day of Oct. 1907, by and between W. J. Trist of the one part, and J. D. Brewington of the other part, witnesseth:

That the said W. J. Trist for the consideration ^{and} covenants to be paid and performed on the part of the said J. D. Brewington as hereinafter specified has this day let, leased and demise^d and by these presents together lease and demise unto the said J. D. Brewington the following described property, to wit:

Lot $\frac{1}{2}$ of S $\frac{1}{4}$ and Lot 8 of sec. 14, Twp. 20 N., R. 12 E., containing 110 acres more or less, said term of lease to begin on the 1st day Jan 1908, and to continue five years subject to the conditions and restrictions herein after specified and set forth. In consideration of said leasing and renting, the said J. D. Brewington bind himself and promise to pay to the said W. J. Trist as rental for said property, the sum of \$375⁰⁰ Dollars, to be paid in yearly payments of \$75⁰⁰ dollars each, said payments to be paid promptly on the first of each year in advance, and in case of default in any or either said yearly payments for a period of five days after they or either of them shall fall due, then in such event, the said W. J. Trist at his option, shall have the right to declare this lease cancelled, and the right to re-enter and retake possession of said property, without let, hind or hindrance.

Said second party has right to place any improvements on said land and remove same at the expiration of said lease.

The said party of first part reserves 10 acres out of the N.E. corner of said allotment to build or plant
