 Witnesseth, that the parties of the first part, in  
 consideration of the sum of Twenty \$20.00 Dollars, to him in hand  
 paid, the receipt whereof is truly acknowledged, have sold and  
 by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey to said  
 party of the second part, Benjamin McIntosh, and assigns forever all  
 that tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Tulsa  
 and State of Oklahoma, described as follows, to-wit:

Lots three (3) and four (4) of section one (1) Township  
 sixteen (16) North, Range twelve (12) east of the Indian Base  
 and meridian containing 82.15 acres more or less according to  
 the government survey and plat thereof. This mortgage is  
 subject to a mortgage of nine hundred dollars to Benjamin  
 McIntosh Guardian of William McIntosh of even date  
 herewith with all appurtenances and all the estate, title and  
 interest of the said parties of the first part therein. And the  
 said parties of the first part do hereby warrant and agree  
 that as the above things that they are the lawful owners  
 of the premises above, granted, and seized of a good and  
 indefeasible estate of inheritance therein, free and clear of all  
 incumbrances that have good rights to sell and convey  
 said premises and that they will warrant and defend  
 the same against the lawful claims of all persons
