

This Indenture, Made this 13th day of February A. D. 1908, between
William Durham and Nancy Durham
 of Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and
George G. Bayne
 of Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the second part:

WITNESSETH, That said part 1 of the first part, in consideration of the sum of
Seven hundred and 40 Dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,
 do by these presents Grant, Bargain, Sell and Convey unto said part 2 of the second part his heirs and assigns, the following described
 REAL ESTATE, situated in the City of Tulsa County, and State of Oklahoma, to-wit: a part of Lot 100

Block one hundred and four (104) having a frontage of five (5) feet on main street and extending
in a westerly direction, parallel with south third street to a depth of twenty five (25) feet
more particularly described as follows: Beginning on the easterly line of Block one hundred
and four (104) at a point in said line (35) feet from the corner of said block, thence
thence thence south (35) feet in a westerly direction, parallel with main street,
thence twenty five (25) feet in an easterly direction to the easterly line of said Block one
hundred and four (104) thence five (5) feet along said line to place of beginning.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, unto the said part 2 of the second part his heirs and assigns, together with all and
 singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto ^{more} belonging, or in anywise appertaining, forever.

PROVIDED, ALWAYS, And these presents are upon this express condition, that whereas said William Durham
& Nancy Durham have of this day executed and delivered one certain
 promissory note in writing to said part 2 of the second part, described as follows: of which the following is a copy.

#700.00 Tulsa, Oklahoma Feb 13, 1908
One year after date, we, or either of us, promise to pay to the order of
George G. Bayne - seven hundred & 40 - dollars. For value received, negotiable
and payable at office of Union Trust Company, Tulsa, Oklahoma without discount
or discount, with interest from date at the rate of eight percent per annum until
paid, and if interest be not paid annually, to become an principal and bear same
interest. The drawer and endorser severally reserve the right of payment,
protest and notice of protest, and non payment of this note, and agree to pay
attorneys fees, all court costs, and all other expenses incurred in collecting
this note and interest, or any part thereof.

Now, if said part 1 of the first part shall pay or cause to be paid to said part 2 of the second part his heirs or assigns, said
 sum of money in the above described note mentioned, together with the interest thereon, according to the terms and tenor of the same, then this
these presents mortgage shall be wholly discharged and void; and otherwise shall remain in full force and effect. But if said sum or sums of money, or any part
 thereof, or any interest thereon, is not paid when the same is due, and if the taxes and assessments of every nature, which are or may be assessed and
 levied against said premises or any part thereof are not paid when the same are by law made due and payable, the whole of said sum or sums, and
 interest thereon, shall then become due and payable, and said part 2 of the second part shall be entitled to the possession of said premises. And the
 said part 1 of the first part for said consideration do hereby expressly waive an appraisement of said real estate and all benefit of the homestead
 exemption and stay laws of the State of Oklahoma.
