

This Indenture, Made this 25 day of March A. D. 1908, between H. D. Hartley
and Alice Hartley husband and wife
 of Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and Sallie E. Gray
 of Missouri County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the second part:

WITNESSETH, That said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of
Six hundred Dollars, (\$600.00) the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,
 do by these presents Grant, Bargain, Sell and Convey unto said party of the second part her heirs and assigns, the following described
 REAL ESTATE, situated in Tulsa County, and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

all of Lot Twelve, Block fourteen according to the recorded plat of
the Lynch and Forsythe Addition to the town of Tulsa, in the
above County and state.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, unto the said party of the second part her heirs and assigns, together with all and
 singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in anywise appertaining, forever.

PROVIDED, ALWAYS, And these presents are upon this express condition, that whereas said H. D. Hartley and
Alice Hartley his wife have this day executed and delivered one certain
 promissory note in writing to said party of the second part, described as follows:

Dated March 25, 1908.

Amount Six hundred dollars with eight per cent interest
from date: to run two years from date.

Signed by H. D. Hartley and Alice Hartley

Now, if said parties of the first part shall pay or cause to be paid to said party of the second part her heirs or assigns, said
 sum of money in the above described note mentioned, together with the interest thereon, according to the terms and tenor of the same, then this
 mortgage shall be wholly discharged and void; and otherwise shall remain in full force and effect. But if said sum or sums of money, or any part
 thereof, or any interest thereon, is not paid when the same is due, and if the taxes and assessments of every nature, which are or may be assessed and
 levied against said premises or any part thereof are not paid when the same are by law made due and payable, the whole of said sum or sums, and
 interest thereon, shall then become due and payable, and said party of the second part shall be entitled to the possession of said premises. And the
 said parties of the first part for said consideration do hereby expressly waive an appraisalment of said real estate and all benefit of the homestead
 exemption and stay laws of the State of Oklahoma.
