the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do es by these presents Grant, Bargain, Sell and Convey unto the said  
part of of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the  
County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The Westerly fifty feet of lot 5 in block 102, in Tulsa, Oklahoma,  
according to the Government plat thereof, being a rectangular  
piece of ground fifty by one hundred feet, described as follows  
to-wit: Beginning at the south west corner of lot 5, Block 102,  
thence northwesterly along lot line one hundred feet, to the  
north west corner of lot 5, thence easterly along lot line  
fifty feet, thence westerly parallel with the west line  
of lot 5, one hundred feet to the south line of lot 5,  
thence westerly fifty feet along lot line to place of  
beginning.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and  
appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, forever.

And said Nellie Chesley for her  
heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part of of the  
second part, that at the delivery of these presents she lawfully seized in her own right of an  
absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted  
and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincumbered of  
and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments, and incumbrances of what nature and  
kind soever  
and that she will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said part of of the second  
part, his heirs and assigns, against said part of of the first part, their heirs, and all and every person  
whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
