 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents Grant, Bargain, Sell and Convey unto the said
 part y of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the
 County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lot ten (10) of Block three (3) in "Highlands
Addition to Tulsa Okla" according to the plan
thereof filed and of record in the office of the
Recorder in and for the County of Tulsa
and State of Oklahoma.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and
 appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, forever.

And said Frank C. Biddings for his
 heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part y of the
 second part, that at the delivery of these presents that he is lawfully seized in own right of an
 absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted
 and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincumbered of
 and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments, and incumbrances of what nature and
 kind soever except as to certain oil & gas lease dated Nov 19th 1906
 and that he will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said part y of the second
 part, his heirs and assigns, against said part y of the first part, his ^{their} heirs, and all and every person
 whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
