This Indenture, Made this 15th day of February A. D. 1908, between  
Anna Henry (nee Vann) and her husband S. H. Henry  
of Tulsa County, in the State  
of Oklahoma, of the first part, and S. P. Lewis and W. O. Dickinson  
of the second part,

WITNESSETH, The said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of  
Five hundred fifteen and 75/100 DOLLARS,  
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents Grant, Bargain, Sell and Convey unto the said  
parties of the second part, Theirs heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the  
County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The north one half (1/2) of the south west quarter (1/4) of  
the south east quarter and south one half of the south east  
quarter of the south west quarter and the north west  
quarter of the south east quarter of the south west  
quarter of section thirty three (33) Township 20, North,  
Range 14 East being 50 acres more or less as the  
case may be.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and  
appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, forever.

And said Anna Henry and S. H. Henry for Theirs  
heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said parties of the  
second part, that at the delivery of these presents that they are lawfully seized in their own right of an  
absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted  
and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincumbered of  
and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments, and incumbrances of what nature and  
kind soever

and that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said parties of the second  
part, Theirs heirs and assigns, against said parties of the first part, Theirs heirs, and all and every person  
whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
