

This Indenture, Made this 12th day of February A. D. 1908, between John W. Gilliland, as attorney in fact for Emma McLean and her wife of Hughes County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and Alabama Land & Loan Company, of Holdenville, Okla., of the second part,

WITNESSETH, The said part of the first part, in consideration of the sum of

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby presents Grant, Bargain, Sell and Convey unto the said part of the second part, its successors and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

All the land allotted to Louis Morrison, deceased, consisting of the southwest quarter of section thirty-four, township nineteen (9) north, and Range ten (10), east, in Creek County, her allotment in Creek Nation. All the lands allotted to George McLean, deceased, by the Commission to the Five Civilized Tribes in an allotment in the Creek Nation, being described as follows: The west 17.58 acres of lot four (4) in section eighteen (18), township eleven (11) north, range ten (10) east; The north west quarter of the northwest quarter of section twenty (20); The north west quarter of the northwest quarter of the northwest quarter of section seven (7), north, and range twelve (12), east, in the County of Hughes.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, forever.

And said John W. Gilliland, as attorney in fact for the said Emma McLean, heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part of the second part, that at the delivery of these presents she is lawfully seized in her own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments, and incumbrances of what nature and kind soever and that she will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said part of the second part, its successors, heirs and assigns, against said part of the first part, her heirs, and all and every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
