

This Indenture, Made this 12th day of February A.D. 1925, between John W. Lillibland as attorney in fact for Emma McList and his wife of Hughes County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and Oklahoma Land & Loan Company of Moldenville, Okla of the second part, WITNESSETH, The said part y of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One and 00/100 and 00 DOLLARS, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby these presents Grant, Bargain, Sell and Convey unto the said part y of the second part, its successors heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Hughes and State of Oklahoma, to-wit: all the land allotted to Laura Morrison, deceased, consisting of the south west quarter of section thirty-two, township nineteen (19) north, and Range ten (10), east, in Creek County, her allotment in Creek Nation; all the land allotted to George McList, deceased, by the Commission to the Five Civilized Tribes as an allotment in the Creek Nation, being described as follows: The west 17.58 acres of lot four (4) in section eighteen (18), township seven (7) north, Range ten (10) east; The north west quarter of the north west quarter of section six (6) The north west quarter of the north west quarter of the north west quarter of section seven, The southwest quarter of the north west quarter of section seven, The northwest quarter of the southeast quarter of the southeast quarter of section seven, all in township seven (7) north, and range twelve (12) east, in the County of Hughes

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, forever.

And said John W. Lillibland as attorney in fact for the said Emma McList for her heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part y of the second part, that at the delivery of these presents she is lawfully seized in her own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments, and incumbrances of what nature and kind soever

and that she will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said part y of the second part, its successors heirs and assigns, against said part y of the first part, her heirs, and all and every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
