 party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the
 County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

All my right, title and interest in and to the
 following described lands to-wit, namely
 The southeast quarter of the north east quarter of
 the south west quarter of section twenty (20) township
 twenty one (21) North Range four (4) East of the
 Indian Base and Meridian, according to the Government
 survey, being a part of the allotment of my deceased
 brother Samuel D. Severe Jr.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and
 appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, forever.

And said Florence E. Putnam for her
 heirs, executors or administrators, does hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the
 second part, that at the delivery of these presents she is lawfully seized in her own right of an
 absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted
 and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincumbered of
 and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments, and incumbrances of what nature and
 kind soever
 and that she will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second
 part, his heirs and assigns, against said part^d of the first part, her heirs, and all and every person
 whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
