This Indenture, Made this 19th day of February A. D. 1905, between
G. H. Blakley, an unmarried man
of Tulsa County, in the State
of Oklahoma, of the first part, and Georgia E. House of Tulsa
Society, a State of Oklahoma of the second part,
WITNESSETH, The said part of the first part, in consideration of the sum of
Thirty thousand dollars and fifty (30,325.00) and two (2) DOLLARS,
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents Grant, Bargain, Sell and Convey unto the said
part of the second part, her heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the
County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

All of the east-fifty feet (50ft) of the west seventy-five feet
(75ft) of lot No 1 and lot 2 in block seventy-four (74)
in the City of Tulsa, as shown by the government
plat of the said City of Tulsa; the same being a parcel
of ground, fifty-one hundred twenty feet (51 x 120 ft)
having a frontage of fifty feet (50ft) on First Street, in
said City of Tulsa.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and
appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, forever.

And said G. H. Blakley for him,
heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part of the
second part, that at the delivery of these presents he is lawfully seized in his own right of an
absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted
and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincumbered of
and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments, and incumbrances of what nature and
kind soever, except the taxes for the year 1905, and the payment thereof now
assured to the holder assessed against said property,
and that I will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said part of the second
part, her heirs and assigns, against said part of the first part, his heirs, and all and every person
whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, except as above set out.
