 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents Grant, Bargain, Sell and Convey unto the said  
 part ies of the second part, their heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the  
 County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The south half of the northwest quarter and Lot No. four (4)  
Section eight (8) and Lot No. five (5) in section four (4) Township  
nineteen (19) Range twelve (12) and Lot two (2) section nine (9)  
township nineteen range twelve and Lot six section three  
(3) township nineteen Range thirteen (13) east - containing in  
all one hundred and sixty four  $\frac{1}{2}$  acres. The above being the  
undivided one eighth interest in the same.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and  
 appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, forever.

And said L. E. Harrison and Laura Harrison for their  
 heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part ies of the  
 second part, that at the delivery of these presents they are lawfully seized in their own right of an  
 absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted  
 and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincumbered of  
 and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments, and incumbrances of what nature and  
 kind soever

and that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said part ies of the second  
 part, their heirs and assigns, against said part ies of the first part, their heirs, and all and every person  
 whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
