

This Indenture, Made this 31st day of December A. D. 1927, between George G. Bayne and Mabel P. Bayne, his wife, of Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and Charles W. Blies of the second part,

WITNESSETH, The said part ~~is~~ of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Eighteen thousand (\$18,000) and ~~Two~~ DOLLARS, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents Grant, Bargain, Sell and Convey unto the said part ~~is~~ of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Part of lot seven (7) in block one hundred four (104) in the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma according to the United States survey thereof; and more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the southwesterly corner of said lot seven (7) in block one hundred four (104), and thence in a westerly direction along the northwesterly line of west third street a distance of seventy-five (75) feet, thence in a northerly direction and parallel with the westerly line of main street a distance of fifty (50) feet thence in a easterly direction and parallel with the northwesterly line of west third street a distance of seven and one-half (7 1/2) feet to main street, thence in a southerly direction along the westerly line of main street a distance of fifty (50) feet to place of beginning.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, forever.

And said George G. Bayne and Mabel P. Bayne, his wife, their heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part ~~is~~ of the second part, that at the delivery of these presents they are lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments, and incumbrances of what nature and kind soever except assessments and taxes subsequent to year of 1917 and that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said part ~~is~~ of the second part, his heirs and assigns, against said part ~~is~~ of the first part, their heirs, and all and every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
