addition according to survey and plat thereof

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and  
 appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining, forever.

And said grantors for their  
 heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the  
 second part, that at the delivery of these presents me lawfully seized in his own right of an  
 absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted  
 and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincumbered of  
 and from all former and other titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments, and incumbrances of what nature and  
kind, soever, except  
 and that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second  
 part, their heirs and assigns, against said party of the first part, his heirs, and all and every person,  
 whosoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
