 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents Grant, Bargain, Sell and Convey unto the said
 part y of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the
 County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lot six (6) in block ten (10) in second Sunday
addition to City of Tulsa according to plat and survey
thereof.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and
 appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining, forever.

And said Grantor for their
 heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part y of the
 second part, that at the delivery of these presents all lawfully seized in their own right of an
 absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of any in and to all and singular the above granted
 and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincumbered of
 and from all former any what grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments, and incumbrances of what nature and
 kind, what soever except
 and that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said part y of the second
 part, his heirs and assigns, against said part us of the first part, his heirs, and all and every person,
 whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
