WITNESSETH, The said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of

 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents Grant, Bargain, Sell and Convey unto the said
 part of the second part, *his* heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the
 County of *Okfuska* and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

*The South half of Southeast quarter and Northeast
 quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Seventeen (17)
 Township Eighteen (18) North Range thirteen (13) East
 of the Indian Meridian.*

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and
 appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, forever.

And said *W. Thornburgh and Anna C. Thornburgh* for themselves ^{the} and their
 heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the
 second part, that at the delivery of these presents *they are* lawfully seized in *their* own right of an
 absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in ^{and} to all and singular the above granted
 and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincumbered of
 and from all former ^{and other} grants, titles, charges, ^{judgments} *judgments*, taxes, assessments, and incumbrances of what nature ^{or} *and*
 kind soever

and that *they* will warrant and forever defend ~~the title to~~ ^{the} the same unto said party of the second
 part, *his* heirs and assigns, against ^{the} said parties of the first part, *their* heirs, and all and every person,
 whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
