 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents Grant, Bargain, Sell and Convey unto the said
 parties of the second part, their heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the

nineteen (19) north and Range fourteen (14) E of the Indian
base + meridian This being the land allotted to

#31569 on the Rolls of Citizen Creek Nation at Muskogee
Okla, she (Millie Norfor) being now deceased without
issue

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and
 appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, forever.

And said Grantor for himself his heirs for
 heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part ies of the
 second part, that at the delivery of these presents he is lawfully seized in his own right of an
 absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted
 and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincumbered of
 and from all former and other grants, titles, charges, estates judgments, taxes, assessments, and incumbrances of what nature or
 kind soever except
 and that he will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said part ies of the second
 part, their heirs and assigns, against said part y of the first part, his heirs, and all and every person
 whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
