 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents Grant, Bargain, Sell and Convey unto the said
 party of the second part, their heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the
 County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Twenty five feet facing Main Street (25 ft) and
one hundred forty feet deep and known as lot
(#13) ~~thirteen~~ and block (#10) ~~eighteen~~ in the town of
Jenks, Oklahoma according to the official town plat
and map.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and
 appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, forever.

And said Stan Parker for himself
 heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the
 second part, that at the delivery of these presents was lawfully seized in his own right of an
 absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted
 and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincumbered of
 and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments, and incumbrances of what nature and
 kind soever
 and that he will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second
 part, his heirs and assigns, against said party of the first part, his heirs, and all and every person
 whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
