 part y of the second part, <sup>unto his</sup> heirs and assigns, <sup>all</sup> of the following described real estate, situated in the  
 County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The east one half of the north west one (1/4) fourth, and lots one  
and two (2) of section seven township nineteen (19) north, and  
range fourteen (14) east, containing one hundred and sixty acres  
more or less as the case may be.
