WITNESSETH, The said part y of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Seven hundred and fifty and no DOLLARS,
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby these presents Grant, Bargain, Sell and Convey unto the said
 part y of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the
 County of Owasa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

An undivided one half interest in and to the south-
 west quarter (SW 1/4) of Section Twelve (12) Township nineteen
 (19) north, range, eleven (11) east, containing one hundred
 and sixty acres more or less according to the United
 States survey thereof, and being the allotment of Thomas Adams,
 deceased.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and
 appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, forever.

And said Salina Harjo, heir at law of Thomas Adams, deceased
 heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part y of the
 second part, that at the delivery of these presents she is lawfully seized in her own right of an
 absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted
 and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincumbered of
 and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments, and incumbrances of what nature and
 kind soever
 and that she will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said part y of the second
 part, his heirs and assigns, against said part y of the first part, their heirs, and all and every person
 whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
