This Indenture, Made this 28th day of May A. D. 1908, between
Emma Bough nee Childers & Arthur Bough her husband ^{deceased} Charles Page
and heirs at law of Samuel Childers ^{deceased} Charles Page County, in the State
 of Oklahoma, of the first part, and Charles Page

of the second part,

WITNESSETH, The said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of
One hundred and twenty five and no 100 DOLLARS,
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents Grant, Bargain, Sell and Convey unto the said
 part of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the
 County of Owasa and Creek and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lot one and two (1-2) and southwest quarter of the northeast
quarter (SW 1/4 of NE 1/4) and south east quarter of northeast
quarter (SE 1/4 of NE 1/4) of section four (4) Township nineteen (19)
north range twelve (12) and east half of the northeast
quarter of the northwest quarter (E 1/2 of NE 1/4 of NW 1/4) and
East half of the west half of the northeast quarter of the
north west quarter (E 1/2 of W 1/2 of NE 1/4 of NW 1/4) of section thirty
two (32) Township fifteen (15) north range seven (7) east
according to the United States survey thereof and being the
allotment of Samuel Childers deceased;

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and
 appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, forever.

And said Emma Bough nee Childers & Arthur Bough ^{her husband} ^{heirs at law of Samuel Childers deceased} for their
 heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part of the
 second part, that at the delivery of these presents they are lawfully seized in their own right of an
 absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted
 and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincumbered of
 and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments, and incumbrances of what nature and
 kind soever

and that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said part of the second
 part, his heirs and assigns, against said part of the first part, their heirs, and all and every person
 whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
