 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do all by these presents Grant, Bargain, Sell and Convey unto the said
 part of of the second part, her heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the
 County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

all that part of lot two (2) in block one hundred ninety nine
(199) in the original town of Tulsa (N) Oklahoma, commencing at a
point 213 feet southeast on line of South Detroit Ave. from the north
westerly corner of block 199. thence 43 feet south easterly with the
east line of said south Detroit Ave. to a stake. thence at right
angle northeasterly to the east line of said block 199, thence north
on east line of said block 45 feet more or less.

thence southwesterly to the place of beginning. The main body
of the tract of land described to be 43 feet wide at each point
excepting where line is not run at right angle at east
end of this tract.
