This Indenture, Made this 29th day of May A. D. 1900, between  
Rachel Dough, nee Childers of Tulsa County, in the State  
 of Oklahoma, of the first part, and Charles Page of the second part,

WITNESSETH, The said part 1 of the first part, in consideration of the sum of  
Two hundred and fifty and no DOLLARS,  
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents Grant, Bargain, Sell and Convey unto the said  
 part 2 of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the  
 County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lots one and two (1-2) and southwest quarter of the northeast  
quarter (SW 1/4 of NE 1/4) and southeast quarter of the northeast quarter  
(SE 1/4 of NE 1/4) of section four (4) township thirteen (13) north, range  
twelve (12) east, and east half of the northeast quarter of the  
northeast quarter (E 1/2 of NE 1/4 of NE 1/4) and east half of the west half  
of the northeast quarter of the northwest quarter (E 1/2 of W 1/2 of NE 1/4 of  
NW 1/4) of section thirty two (32) township fifteen (15) north, range  
seven (7) east, containing 160 acres more or less according to the  
United States survey thereof, and being the allotment of Samuel  
Childers, deceased.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and  
 appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, forever.

And said Rachel Dough nee Childers for her  
 heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part 2 of the  
 second part, that at the delivery of these presents she was lawfully seized in her own right of an  
 absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted  
 and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincumbered of  
 and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments, and incumbrances of what nature and  
 kind soever

and that she will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said part 2 of the second  
 part, his heirs and assigns, against said part 1 of the first part, her heirs, and all and every person  
 whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
