This Indenture, Made this 3rd day of June A. D. 1921, between
Alex Williams, unmarried
 of Tulsa County, in the State

of Oklahoma, of the first part, and

J. D. Weirick of the second part,

WITNESSETH, The said part X of the first part, in consideration of the sum of

One & 10/100ths and 100 DOLLARS,

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do Id. by these presents Grant, Bargain, Sell and Convey unto the said
 part X of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the
 County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The east half of the northwest quarter (E $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$) and the
 east half of the southwest quarter of the northwest quarter
 (E $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$) all of section twenty-five (25) and of
 township seventeen (17) north and of range thirteen (13)
 east of the Indian Base and meridian. This deed is
 made to correct a certain deed given by first party hereto
 to second party hereto and covering the same land as above
 described, but in which deed the grantee's name was
 spelled J. D. Weirick instead of J. D. Weirick, said former
 deed being dated August 10th, 1917.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and
 appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, forever.

And said Alex Williams for himself

heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part X of the
 second part, that at the delivery of these presents he lawfully seized in his own right of an
 absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted
 and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincumbered of
 and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments, and incumbrances of what nature and
 kind soever

and that he will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said part X of the second
 part, his heirs and assigns, against said part X of the first part, his heirs, and all and every person
 whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
