 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents Grant, Bargain, Sell and Convey unto the said  
 part 2<sup>d</sup> of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the  
 County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The twenty three seven feet (23.7 ft) of lot number  
eleven (11) in Block number one (1), in Block Addition  
to the City of Tulsa

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and  
 appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining, forever.

And said Grantor for himself  
 heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part 2<sup>d</sup> of the  
 second part, that at the delivery of these presents they are lawfully seized in their own right of an  
 absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted  
 and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincumbered of  
 and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments, and incumbrances of what nature and  
 kind soever except taxes and assessments for the year 1908, and subsequent  
years, including general, special, sewer, and sidewalk taxes, which the said grantor  
and that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said part 2<sup>d</sup> of the second  
 part, his heirs and assigns, against said part 1<sup>st</sup> of the first part, their heirs, and all and every person  
 whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
