

From Edward M. Coy et al to Cresence Clay

This Indenture, Made this 13th day of June A. D. 1908, between  
Edward M. Coy and Harriet P. his wife  
 of  Tulsa  County, in the State  
 of Oklahoma, of the first part, and Cresence Clay,  
 of the second part,

WITNESSETH, The said part ies of the first part, in consideration of the sum of  
One hundred & fifty and \$150 DOLLARS,  
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents Grant, Bargain, Sell and Convey unto the said  
 party of the second part, her heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the  
 County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lot Ten (10) in Block Four (4) in Highlands Second  
Addition to Tulsa Okla. according to the Plat thereof  
filed and of record in the office of the Recorder in  
and for the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and  
 appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, forever.

And said Edward M. Coy and Harriet P. his wife for their  
 heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the  
 second part, that at the delivery of these presents they are lawfully seized in their own right of an  
 absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted  
 and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincumbered of  
 and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments, and incumbrances of what nature and  
 kind soever except a certain Gas lease dated Nov. 19th 1906. But no drilling shall  
be done under said lease on above lot without the consent of 2nd party.  
 and that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second  
 part, her heirs and assigns, against said part ies of the first part, their heirs, and all and every person  
 whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
