WITNESSETH, The said part 1 of the first part, in consideration of the sum of  
four hundred and no DOLLARS,  
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents Grant, Bargain, Sell and Convey unto the said  
 part 2 of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the  
 County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lots numbered 4-5-6-7-8-9-10-11-12-13, block number 13 in the Tulsa  
Oil & Gas Land and Gas subdivision of the southwest quarter (SW 1/4)  
of the southwest quarter (SW 1/4) of section 27, and the southwest  
quarter (SE 1/4) of the southeast quarter (SE 1/4) of section 27,  
township 21 north, range 13 east, as shown on map of  
said subdivision now on record in the office of Register  
of Deeds, in the town of Tulsa, County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and  
 appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, forever.

And said C. D. McCollough for or his  
 heirs, executors or administrators, do ad hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part 2 of the  
 second part, that at the delivery of these presents he is lawfully seized in his own right of an  
 absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted  
 and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincumbered of  
 and from all former and other grants, titles, charges, settle judgments, taxes, assessments, and incumbrances of what nature or  
 kind soever

and that he will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said part 2 of the second  
 part, his heirs and assigns, against said part 1 of the first part, his heirs, and all and every person  
persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
