WITNESSETH, The said part y of the first part, in consideration of the sum of
Two hundred fifty and 00/100 DOLLARS,
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do ce by these presents Grant, Bargain, Sell and Convey unto the said
 part y of the second part, he heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the
 County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

North east quarter (N.E. 1/4) of the (S.W. 1/4)
south west quarter of the south west quarter
(S.W. 1/4) of section fifteen (15) township twenty (20)
N. Range thirteenth (13) E. of the Indian Meridian

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and
 appurtenances thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining, forever.

And said Tupac Roach for himself and for his
 heirs, executors or administrators, do ce hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part y of the
 second part, that at the delivery of these presents he is lawfully seized in his own right of an
 absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted
 and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincumbered of
 and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments, and incumbrances of what nature and
 kind soever
 and that he will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said part y of the second
 part, he heirs and assigns, against said part y of the first part, his heirs, and all and every person
 whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
