A parcel of land, being part of block numbered two hundred and one (201) in the city of Tulsa according to the amended plat and survey thereof, and more particularly described as follows begin at a point fifty (50) feet southerly from the northeasterly corner of said block 201, on west line of Cincinnati Ave, thence westerly parallel with south line of 11th Street, one hundred and forty feet (140) to an alley; thence southerly with east line of said alley fifty (50) feet, thence easterly, parallel with the northerly line of said parcel of land, One hundred and forty (140) feet to Cincinnati Ave, thence northerly with west line of Cincinnati Avenue fifty (50) feet to place of beginning.
