ASSIGNMENT OF AN OIL AND GAS LEASE .

WHEREAS, The Secretary of the Interior has heretofore approved an oil and gas mining lease dated September 19 1905 entered into by and between Plymouth Oil Company of Bartlesville Oklahoma, lessee and Jennie Archilla of Spavinaw, Oklahoma a lessor, covering the following described lands in what was formally the Cherokee Nation of the Indian Territory, and what is now Washington County, Oklahoma, To-wit :-

The west half of the Northwest quarter of the Northeast quarter and the East half of the Northeast quarter of the Northwest quarter and the southwest quarter of the Northeast quarter of the Northwest quarter, Section Nineteen (19) Township Twenty (20) North Range Thirteen (13) East of the Indian Meridian, containing fifty (50) acres more or less .

Now therefore, for and in consideration of Five Thousand Dollars (\$ 5000.) the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged the said Plymouth Oil Company , the lessee in the above described lease, hereby bargains, sells transfers, assigns and conveys all the right, title and interest of the lessee and to said lease subject to the approval of the Secretary of the Interior to Alpine Oil Company, a corporation of Tulsa Oklahoma .
