

First parties to have gas free for fuel and light in the dwelling on said premises by making their own connections to any well thereon.

It is agreed that the second party shall have the privilege of using sufficient water oil and gas from said premises to run all machinery necessary for drilling and operating thereon and at any time to remove all machinery and fixtures placed on said premises; and further, upon the payment of One Dollars, by the party of the second part, his heirs, administrators, executors, successors and assigns, to the party of the first part, their heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, said party of the second part his heirs, executors, administrators successors and assigns, shall have the right to surrender this lease for cancellation, after which all payments and liabilities thereafter to accrue under and by virtue of its terms shall cease and determine, and this lease become absolutely null and void.

ORDER OF CONFIRMATION.

It appearing to the Court at a hearing on the 11th, day of December, 1908, that on the 27th, day of November, 1908, Emily M. Campbell, executrix in the above entitled cause, filed her petition in this Court praying for the confirmation of the sale of the land herein described; and,

It further appearing to the Court that on the said 27th, day of November, 1908, the Court made an order setting the 11th, day of December, 1908 for the hearing of said petition, and in said order required the publication of a notice of said hearing for a period of ten days previous to the said 11th, day of December, 1908; and,
