And in case of non-payment then the said grantee or assignee's shall have power to sell said property at public sale, to the highest bidder, for ca sh, at Red Fork in Tulsa County Oklahoma notice of the time and plack of said sale having first been given 30 days by advertising in some newspaper published in said district, by at least two insertions or by notices posted in ten public places in the District, at which sale the said grantee or his assignee may bid and purchase as any third person might do hereby authorizing the said grante e or assignee to convey said property to anyone purchasing at said sale, and to coney an absolute title thereo and the recitals of his deed of conveyance shall be taken as Prima Facie true and the proceeds of said sale shall be appled, first, to the payment of all costs and expenses attanding said sale; second, to the payment of said debt and interest, and the remainder, if any, shall be paid to said grantor .
