ORDER OF COURT.

IN THE COUNTY COURT OF TULSA COUNTY, O K L A H O M A /

IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF MADIE BUCKTROT, LUCY FOX (NEE BUCKTROT) AND NANNIE FULSOM  
(NEE BUCKTROT) FOR THE APPROVAL OF SALE OF REAL ESTATE. . . O R D E R.

Now, on this 12th, day of December, 1908, this cause coming on to be heard on the application of Madie ~~Cotanny~~ (formerly Bucktrot) Lucy Fox (nee Bucktrot) and Nannie Fulson (nee Bucktrot) for the approval of a conveyance made by them of their interest in the West Half of the West Half of Section 22, Township 17 North, of Range 13 East of the Indian Meridian, in Tulsa County Oklahoma, to G. W. Barnes, and the Court after hearing the testimony, and being fully advised in the premises finds: That said land was allotted to John Soffie, a full blood Creek Indian, as his share of the lands of the Creek Nation, that said John Soffie died August 21, 1902, leaving no wife, no father, no mother, no sisters, no children or descendants of children but leaving as his sole heir at law, his brother, Bucktrot, who inherited said lands at the death of said John Soffie; that said Bucktrot was a full-blood citizen of the Creek Nation of Indians, and so enrolled, and died some two or three months after the death of the said John Soffie, leaving a widow named Madie Bucktrot, sometimes called Wydie Bucktrot, but who has since married ~~Cotanny~~ <sup>and is now named Cotanny</sup>, and is one of the above named petitioners.

The Court further finds that the said Bucktrot at his death left the following children: Nannie Fulson (nee Bucktrot) over eighteen years of age; Lucy Fox (nee Bucktrot) over eighteen years of age; Wysena Bucktrot, age 15 years; Sam Green Bucktrot, age 13 years; Cozzey Bucktrot, age 11 years; Agee Bucktrot, age 9 years, and Sagie Bucktrot, age 5 years;

The Court further finds that Madie Cotanny (formerly Bucktrot) holds a dower interest of one third of said land for her life time, and that the said Nannie Folsom (nee Bucktrot) and Lucy Fox (nee Bucktrot) each inherited and now own one-seventh (1/7) interest in said land subject to the said dower interest of the said Madie Cottanny, that the said Nannie Fulson and Lucy Fox are each over eighteen years of age; that the said Madie Cotanny and Nannie Fulson and Lucy Fox have each sold their interest in said land to G. W. Barnes for the sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) each, that said sum is a fair and reasonable value for said land; that it is to the best interest of the said petitioners that their interest be sold.

It is therefore considered/ ordered and adjudged and decreed, that the conveyance by Madie Cotanny (nee Bucktrot) Lucy Fox (nee Bucktrot) and Nannie Folsom (nee Bucktrot) of their interest in above described lands to G. W. Barnes of Muskogee, Oklahoma, is hereby in all things approved and confirmed.
