ORDER OF COURT.

IN THE COUNTY COURT OF TULSA COUNTY, STATE OF OKLAHOMA.

IN THE MATTER OF THE ALIENATION OF THE ALLOTMENTS OF MARY KELLY AND REUBEN KELLY, BY LOUINA KELLY, AN HEIR. .) ORDER.

This matter came on to be heard on this 29th day of September, 1908, upon the petition of Louina Kelly, praying for the order of this Court approving a certain deed by her executed, conveying her interest in the allotment of the said Mary Kelly, deceased, and Reuben Kelly, deceased, to one Charles Page.

Said petitioner appearing in person and by her attorneys Abbott & Brown, and the Court after hearing the testimony of the petitioner and disinterested witnesses, and after hearing the argument of counsel and being fully advised in the premises, finds:

That the allegations in the petition contained are true; that the said Mary Kelly deceased, and Reuben Kelly, deceased, were full blood Creek Indians and were duly enrolled as such; that by reason thereof there was allotted to the said Mary Kelly, deceased, the following described land, situate in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, to wit:

The West Half of the Southwest Quarter and Lot 8, both in Section 9, and the East Half of the Southeast Quarter and Lot 7, both in Section 8, all in Township 19 North, Range 12 East, and that there was allotted to the said Reuben Kelly the following described land, situate in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to wit:

The Southwest Quarter of Section 17, Township 19 North, Range 12 East, and that the said Mary Kelly and Reuben Kelly died seized of the above lands, as respectively set out, and died intestate.

The Court further finds that the said Mary Kelly died on or about theday of 1901, and that the said Reuben Kelly died on or about theday of 1903; and that both of them died in what is now Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma. That there was no issue born to them or to either of them since the 4th, day of March 1906, and that the petitioner Louina Kelly is of full and legal age.

The Court further finds that on the 29th day of September, 1906, the petitioner whom the Court finds was a sister of the said Mary Kelly, deceased and the said Reuben Kelly deceased, made, executed and delivered a quit claim deed conveying the lands above described and her interest therein to one Charles Page and A. F. Ault, in consideration of the sum of \$500.00 which said consideration the Court finds was adequate, and which deed is herewith presented for the approval of the Court.

WHEREFORE, it is by the Court Considered, ordered, adjudged and decreed that the said deed, above described be and the same is hereby approved, according to section 9, of an act of Congress approved May 27th, 1908, entitled, "An Act for the removal of restrictions from part of the lands of the allottees of the Five Civilized Tribes; and for other purposes".
