PARTIAL RELEASE OF MORTGAGES

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:, That we, Murrell and Spicknall, a co-partnership composed of William D. Murrell and William R. Spicknall, of Kansas City, State of Missouri, do hereby release the West half of the East half of the South East Quarter of Section Thirty Three (33) and the East Half of the west Half of the Southwest Quarter of Section Thirty Four (34) all of Township Eighteen (18) North and of Range Fourteen (14) East of the Indian Base and Meridian in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, and the West Half of the East Half of the Northeast Quarter of Section Four (4) and the East Half of the West Half of the Northwest Quarter of Section Three (3) all of Township Seventeen (17) North and of Range Fourteen (14) East of the Indian Base and Meridian in the County of Wagoner and State of Oklahoma from the operation and lien of two (2) certain mortgages, both dated November 16th, 1908; executed by Arthur R. Perryman and Daisy G. Perryman, husband and wife, in our favor; and filed for record in the office of the Register of Deeds of Wagoner County, State of Oklahoma/ on November 19th, 1908.

One of said mortgages is for Twenty Five Hundred Dollars (\$2500.00), is due November 1st, 1911, and is recorded in Book 38, at pge 350 of the records of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, and the other is for Two Hundred, Sixty Two and 50/100 Dollars, (\$262.50), is due November 1st, 1909, and is recorded in Book 38, at page 352 of the records of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma.

The consideration of this release is the fact that said premises and lands were unintentionally and erroneously included in said mortgages and this release is therefore made for the purposes of releasing said premises from the lien, if any, and clearing said premises and land from the cloud, if any, created thereon by said mortgages, but this release is not intended to and shall not cancel or release the lien granted in and created by said mortgages on the East Half of the East Half of the Southeast Quarter of Section Thirty Three (33) and the West Half of the West Half of the Southwest Quarter of section Thirty Four (34) all in Township Eighteen (18) North and of Range Fourteen (14) East of the Indian Base and Meridian in said Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, and the East Half of the East Half of the Northeast Quarter of Section Four (4) and the West Half of the West Half of the Northwest Quarter of Section Three (3) all in Township Seventeen (17) North and of Range Fourteen (14) East of the Indian Base and Meridian in said County of Wagoner and State of Oklahoma and containing in the aggregate One Hundred and Sixty (160) acres, more or less, according to the allotment deed and the homestead Deed issued to the said Arthur R. Perryman therefor, and the lien granted in and created by said mortgages on all of said One Hundred and Sixty (160) acres of land last above described shall stand and remain in full force and effect until the debt stated in said mortgage is and shall have been paid in full, no part of said debt having yet been paid/
