2. To pay One Hundred and Fifty dollars per year for the gas from each and every well drilled on said premises, the product of which is ten million cubic feet per day; and one hundred dollars per year for the gas from each and every well drilled on said premises, the product of which is seven million cubic feet per day, provided such gas be marketed and used off the premises; said payments to be made on each well within sixty days after commencing to use the gas thereform as aforesaid, and to be jaid yearly thereafter while the gas from said wells is used.

In case gas is founf in marketable quantities, party of the first part'shall have the right to gas for domestic purposes free by making her own connections.

Second party covenants and agrees to locate all wells so as to interefere as little as possible with the cultivated portions of the farm, and agrees further to put down all wells necessary for the protection of the lines of this lease.

Second party covenants and agrees to complete a well for oil and gas on said premises within one year from the date hereof, and for faulure so to do, this lease shall be void and of no effect.

It is agreed that the second party is to have the privilege of using sufficient water from said premises to run all necessary machinery, and at any time to remove all machinery and fixtures placed on said premises.
