KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That I, Harry Brown of Lee ,Creek Nation, Western Judicial Dis-
trict of the Indian Territory, being of sound and disposing mind and memory, and being desirous
to settle my worldly affairs whilst I have strength and capacity so to do, do hereby make, pub-
lish and declare this my last will and testament, that is to say:

First. I will and direct that all my just debts be paid.

Second. Of my personal estate I will, devise and bequeath to my brother George Brown, my interest in and to all cattle branded JS on left side and X on left jaw.

Third. Of my real property, I will, devise and bequeath to my brother George Brown, my allotment consisting of 160 acres of land, situated in the Creek Nation, to have and to hold and enjoy, to him and his heirs forever.

I hereby make constitute and appoint my beloved brother George Brown, executor of this my last will and testament without bond.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I, the said Harry Brown, have hereunto set my hand and seal, at Lee, Indian Territory, on this the 22nd, day of April, A. D., 1905.
