The party of the second part, its successors or assigns, shall have the right at any time on the payment of one (\$1.00) Dollar and all payable obligations then due to the party of the first part, his heirs or assigns, to surrender this lease for cancellation after which all payments and liabilities hereafter to accrue under and by virtue of its terms shall cease and terminate.

All covenants and agreements herein set forth between the parties heretofore shall extend to their successors, heirs, executors, administrators and assigns.
