## ORDER OF COURT.

IN THE COUNTY COURT OF TULSA COUNTY, O K L A H O M A.

IN THE MATTER OF THE GUARDIANSHIP OF PERRY E. HAWORTH, ET. AL. OWEN H. HAWORTH, GUARDIAN.)

Now, on this 23rd, day of December, 1908, this matter comes on for hearing for confirmation of oil and gas leases made by Owen H. Haworth, guardian of the person and estate of Perry E. Haworth, Edgar M. Haworth, Claude W. Haworth, Grace Haworth and Owen E. Haworth, Jr., minors, to the Alpine Oil Company, as authorized and empowered, pursuant to an order of this Court dated on the 15th day of December, 1908; and it appearing to the Court that the petitioner herein, Owen H. Haworth, is the father and guardian of said minors, and that it is to the interest of the said minors to lease their said lands for oil and gas purposes and that all said parties are residents of the County Of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma: And it appearing further to the Court that notice for bids of leasing said allotments has been properly given in pursuance of an order of this Court dated the 15th day of December, 1908, to wit: for publication of notices of said leasing for two weeks in the Tulsa Chief, a weekly newspaper published in Tulsa County, Oklahoma; and it appearing to the Court that the bid of the Alpine Oil Company for the leasing of the lands of said minors hereinafter set out was the highest and best bid made under and by virtue of the order of Court dated the 15th day of December, 1908, that the said bid was made in writing, and submitted to said guardian on the 23rd, day of December, 1908; and it further appearing to the Court that the order heretofore made in this matter for leasing said lands for oil and gas purposes has been duly complied with in every particular, and there being submitted to this court a true and correct copy of lease executed by said guardian to the highest and best bidder, to wit:

X The Alpine Oil Company, and the court being fully advised in the premises by testimony taken in open Court, finds that said leases executed on the 23rd, day of December, 1908, by said Owen H. Haworth, guardian to the Alpine Oil Company upon the allotment as hereinafter described, should be confirmed and approved as follows, to wit:

Perry E. Haworth:

N/2 of NW/4 of Section 13, Township 20 North, Range 12 East, containing 80 acres.

Edgar M. Haworth:

NE/4 of SE/4 &amp; NE/4 of SE/4 of SE/4 and SE/4 of SE/4 of SE/4 and W/2 of SE/4 of SE/4

less 2.50 acres Midland valley Railroad right-of-way in section twelve, Township Twenty N.

Range Twelve East, containing 77.50 acres.

Claude W. Haworth:

NW/4 of SW/4 of SE/4 and S/2 of SW/4 of SE/4 and NW/4 of SE/4 less 3.31 acres R. R. right-

of-way and NE/4 of SW/4 of SE/4 less .87 acres R. R. right-of-way, Section 12/ Township 20 North, Range 12 East, and SE/4 of SW/4 of NW/4 of Section 13, Township 20 North, Range 12 East containing 85.82 acres.

Grace Haworth,

W/2 of SW/4 of Section 12 Township 20 North, Range 12 East, containing 80 acres.

Owen H. Haworth, Jr.

SE/4 of NW/4 and NE/4 of NE/4 less 3.15 acres R. R. right-of-way, Section 13, Township

20 North, Range 12 East, Containing 76/85 acres.

It is therefore by the court considered, ordered and adjudged that said leases for oil and gas purposes executed by Owen H. Haworth, guardian, to the Alpine Oil Company for the above named minors and upon the property herein described shall be and the same are hereby in all their terms, covenants, agreements and conditions, ratified, confirmed and approved.
