The second party shall have the right to at any time remove all machinery and fixtures placed/ on said premises, including the right to draw and remove casing from all dry or exausted wells.

The partty of the second part, its heirs, succeesors or assigns shall have the right at ant time on the payment of one dollar and all payable obligations then due to the party of the first part, her heirs or assigns, to surrender this lease for cancellation after which all payments andliablities hereafter to accrue under and by virtue of its terms shall cease and terminate.

All covenants and agreements herein set forth between the parties hereto shall extend to their successors, heirs, executors, administrators and assigns.
