IOne note, for Two Hundred Seventy One and No/100 (\$271.00) Dollars made on the twentieth (20) day of June 1907, and due on the Twentieth (20) day of September 1907, with a credit of one hundred twelve and No/100 s (\$112.00) dollars o n same, and which note has been extended to the fiteenth (15) day of August 1908.

One note for one hundred thirtyOne and 30/100 (\$131.30) made on the twenty-fifth (25) day of May 1907 and due on the fifteenth day (15) of September 1907, with a credit of twenty and No/100s (\$20.00) Dollars on same, which note is extended to the fiteenth (15) day of August 1908.

One note for eight hundred eighty one and No/100s (\$881.00) Dollars made on the eighth (8) day of December 1906, and due on the eighth (8) day of March 1907, with a payment of One Hundred eighty one and No/100s (\$ 18.00) Dollars on same, which not has been extended to the fifteenth (15) day of August 1908.
