It further appearing to the Court that under the terms of the will of the above named decedent, the said will having been admitted to probate in this Court on the IOth., day of December 1907, the executrix, Emily M Campbell the petitioner aforenamed, was authorizzed and empowered to sell and dispose of any and all realestate of said decedent as to her seemed fit and proper; and,
