ORDER APPROVING AND CONFIRMING LEASE.

Now on this 27 day of June, A.D. 1908, this matter coming on to be heard upon the guardian's petition for the approval, ratification and confirmation of an oil and gas mining lease of his ward's lands, described as follows, to-wit:

The South half of the Northeast Quarter, and the South east quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section Twenty-eight (28) Township nineteen (19) North and range Eleven (11) East; the South west quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section Twenty-eight (28) Township nineteen (19) North Range eleven East.

And it appearing to the Court that the said Louis Fulson is the duly appointed, qualified and acting guardian of Willie Fulson, a minor, that this Court has hereinbefore entered an order authorizing and directing him, as such guardian, to execute a lease of the above described lands, the property of his ward, for oil and gas mining purposes to Joseph Bruner for a cash bonus of One Hundred and sixty (\$160.00) Dollars and a royalty of 10% of all oil and gas extracted from said lands, and it appearing that said guardian has executed a lease of said ~~premises~~ lands and the terms and conditions comply with the said order of Court; and the Court being well and sufficiently advised in the premises,

IT IS THEREFORE, considered, ordered, adjudged and decreed, that said lease for oil and gas mining purposes for a term of fifteen (15) years, together with all the acts and doings of said Guardian in connection therewith, be, and the same are hereby, approved and confirmed in all things.
