For and in consideration of Forty Eight (\$48.00) Dollars to me in hand paid, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged I, George Brown, of Boynton Oklahoma, do hereby grant to the Prairie Oil & Gas Company, its successors or assigns, the right of way to lay, maintain, operate and remove a pipe line for the transportation of oil or gas and my lands, situate in Creek County Oklahoma, described as follows, to-wit:

W 1/2 of NW 1/4 Section 1 Township 17 N Range 12 E

S W 1/4 of SW 1/4 Section 1 Township 17 N Range 12 E with ingress and egress to and from the same. The said grantor heirs or assigns to fully use and enjoy the said premises, except for the purposes hereinbefore granted to the said The Prairie Oil & Gas Company which hereby agrees to pay any damages which may arise to crops and fences from the laying, maintaining and operating said pipe line; said damage if not mutually agreed upon, to be ascertained and determined by three disinterested persons, one thereof to be appointed by the said grantor, heirs or assigns, one by the Prairie Oil & Gas Company, its successors or assigns, and the third by the two so appointed as aforesaid, and the award of such three persons shall be final and conclusive. And it is hereby further agreed, that the said The Prairie Oil & Gas Company, its successors or assigns, may at any time lay an additional line of pipe alongside of the first line, as herein provided, upon the payment of a like consideration, and subject to the same conditions; also to have the right to change the size of its pipe, the damage, if any, to crops and surface in making such change to be paid by the said The Prairie Oil & Gas Company
